\$4.6bn allocated to infrastructure by top 20 largest fund commitments

The 20 largest fund commitments made to 2020-vintage funds totalled \$4.6 billion in committed capital. The majority of the largest commitments were to global infrastructure funds managed by leading GPs.

I Squared Capital received four of the commitments, approximately \$1 billion in total.

Among the top 20 2020-vintage private infrastructure commitments, four were made by Teacher Retirement System of Texas.

Average infrastructure allocation for investors globally climbs to 5.05%

Private infrastructure continues to represent an important component of institutional investor portfolios. The average infrastructure investor increased its allocation to the asset class from 4.87 percent as of year-end 2019 to 5.05 percent as of year-end 2020.


Investors are boosting their private infrastructure exposure

Data from Infrastructure Investor reveals that 59 percent of institutional investors globally maintained or increased their allocations to private infrastructure in 2020.

Public pensions displayed above-average appetite, with 68 percent of pensions maintaining or increasing their private infrastructure allocations over the course of 2020.



Proportion of institutions that increased, maintained, or decreased their private infrastructure allocations in 2020








Over a third of LPs have reported being at target allocation in infrastructure

The number of LPs that are underweight has increased gradually since 2018 to 57 percent, while the number of those reporting an overallocation to infrastructure remains low, at 5%



Proportion of institutions over, under, or at their private infrastructure target allocations as of 31 Dec 2020








Appetite across strategies is strong

Findings from *Infrastructure Investor's* LP Perspectives 2021 Study reveal that regardless of strategy, the majority of infrastructure investors plan to maintain or shift more capital into the asset class. The most notable proportion is investor appetite for core-plus strategies, with 85% of LPs planning to invest the same amount of capital or more in the next 12 months compared to the previous 12 months.



Regardless of strategy, the majority of infrastructure investors plan to maintain or shift more capital into infrastructure in the next 12 months compared to the previous 12 months









Regulatory risks are the greatest concern

When it comes to factors that impact performance, infrastructure investors are most concerned about regulatory risks, frothiness in the market, and political instability.

Only 10 percent of investors mentioned rising interest rates as a main concern for performance. This is unsurprising, given that interest rates are expected to remain low for the foreseeable future.
